KEENNESS:

One characterized by strength and distinctness of perception.

see Memory; active

KICKS:**Belladonna**

kicks in sleep.

Chamomilla

child when carried becomes stiff and kicks.

Lycopodium clavatum

child is cross, kicks and scolds on waking. *Cross*

Reference: Striking

KILL, desire to:**Alumina**

the person's identity or individuality has been taken away and there is confusion. This results in loss of self-control and sudden impulse to kill himself by shooting or injuring with a knife.

Hepar sulphuris calcareum

has the feeling of being terribly offended by the person on whom he is dependent. This sets in him a revolution, in which he wants to set things on fire wants to kill.

Hyoscyamus niger

the basic disturbance in hyoscyamus is jealousy and suspicion. He feels deserted by the person whom he loved. This results in fear of being alone and an impulse to kill.

Iodum purum

They are sensitive to all external impressions and to noise. He has fears from every trifle, that some misfortune could arise. Even the thought of real or imaginary wrongs make them very violent with impulse to kill along with palpitation and throbbing carotid arteries.

KILLED, desires to be:

Arsenicum album

feels insecure, alone, isolated and sees the world as threatening. He is anxious, restless, fearful, suspicious about everything. So he feels like stabbing his heart with knife at mid-night out of fright and insecurity.

Phytolacca decandra

there appears to have a total disregard for all surrounding objects, and no disposition to adjust under any circumstances. Sense of entire indifference to life, and disgust for the business of the day. Indisposition to mental exertion, with desire to be killed.

KINDNESS:

see Affectionate. Anxiety; others. Benevolence. Mildness. Sympathetic

KISSED, wants to be:

Stramonium

being kissed, Stramonium feels that he is in the company of loving, caring, protecting people.

KISSES:

Crocus sativus

in Crocus, attractiveness alternates with aggressiveness. The attractiveness is manifested by being affectionate, talkative, kissing, embracing, singing, dancing, jesting. He kisses everybody around him.

Pulsatilla nigricans

These children are extremely affectionate, they manifest this by kissing and caressing.

Veratrum album

kisses everyone in puerperal mania.

see Amativeness. Amorous; disposition. Embraces. Lascivious

KLEPTOMANIA:

An irresistible desire to steal, without regard to personal needs.

Artemisia vulgaris

in a boy with epilepsy.

Belladonna

in mania.

Staphysagria

goes about house in search of something, not knowing what, but if attracted by any object, puts it in his pocket or hides it in his coat.

KNEELING and praying:

see Praying; kneeling and

KNOCKING:

Giving sound or forcible blow to; hitting; striking; beating.

KNIFE; cannot look at:**Alumina**

KNIFE, impulse to injure with:**Alumina**

Arsenicum album

see killed; desire to be.
