Key elements validating the choice of the medicine

Etiology, circumstantial causalities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fever, acute inflammation• Cold on the head• Heat stroke
Targets, pathophysiology and lesions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mucous membranes: digestive, respiratory, ocular -> intense dryness• On the circulatory system -> congestion and high blood pressure• On the nervous system (central and sympathetic)<ul style="list-style-type: none">- sensory hyperesthesia- extremely painful visceral spasms
Sensations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dryness of the mucous membranes• Hot face• Throbbing pain• Cramping pain
Modalities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Aggravation<ul style="list-style-type: none">- bright light- noise- touch- cold- heat on the head
Concomitant symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hot sweats• Radiating heat• Redness of the face
Cravings and aversions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Variable thirst
Mood and behavior	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hypnagogic hallucinations• Fever convulsions• Alternating exhaustion/agitation

Main clinical indications

General syndromes (infections, inflammations...)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Infectious disease • Spasms
Cardiology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bouts of high blood pressure (headache, epistaxis)
Dermatology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scarlet fever-like rash • First degree burn
Endocrinology	
Gastroenterology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Colic (intestinal, renal) • Dental disorders
Ob/gyn	
Ophthalmology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conjunctivitis, sties, dry eye syndrome, intolerance to contact lenses, photophobia
ENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rhinopharyngitis, sore throat, laryngitis, otitis media, sinusitis • Dryness of the mucous membranes

Neurology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hiccup, fever convulsions
Rheumatology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inflammatory flare-up reactions

Etiology, circumstantial causalities

Targets, pathophysiology and lesions

- **Liver**, digestive tract
- Metabolism: urea, uric acid, cholesterol
- **Kidneys** and genital tract
- Skin and mucous membranes
- Nervous system

Sensations

- Lack of stamina
- **Hunger quickly satisfied**
- Bloating at belt level
- **Pruritis improved by cold**
- One foot is hot, the other one is cold

Modalities

- Aggravation
- **between 4 and 8 p.m.**
- confined heat
- contradiction
- Improvement
- **fresh air**
- hot foods
- Predominant **right** laterality

Concomitant symptoms

- Redness after meals

Cravings and aversionss

- Craving for sweets, hot foods, intolerance to onions and oysters

Mood and behavior

Sensitive type

- Frequent association of dermatitis, digestive and urogenital disorders and lack of stamina
- Underdeveloped musculature, they look older than individuals their own age, sometimes facial tics
- Very emotional, **craves affection and lacks self-esteem**.
- Proud and authoritarian behavior**, self-confidence on an intellectual level. Psychological fatigue

Chronic Reactional Modes

- Family or personal history:
- **atopic eczema, anorexia of the newborn**
- **acetonemia**
- **facial tics**
- **dyspeptic disorders**
- **lithiasis**

Cardiology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Atheroma
Dermatology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chronic urticaria (rash) • Eczema that bleeds easily when scratched • Seborrheic dermatitis • Hyperkeratosis and fissure of the heels
Endocrinology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prone to elevated levels of uric acid and uremia • Cholesterol disorders
Gastroenterology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flatulent dyspepsia, constipation • Biliary dyskinesia, lithiasis • Migraine • Duodenal ulcer • Children's anorexia • Acetone-poisoning vomiting

ENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chronic hay fever • Sore throat (right side)
Pulmonology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asthma • Chronic bronchitis • Pneumopathy of the lower right base
Neurology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Headache, migraine, BPPV, facial tics
Rheumatology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gout • Right shoulder periarthritis (frozen shoulder)
Urology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lithiasis • Prostatism • Impotence • Children enuresis
Mood and behavior disorders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reactional depression • Psychological fatigue
