## THE MIASMS

Hahnemann's work on 'Chronic Diseases' is as J.H.CIarke said, "the crowning work of his career." ' This is because in contrast to acute diseases, which tend towards an end, true chronic diseases "alvvays go on increasing and growing worse, not with standing the best mental and corporeal regimeh, and torment the patiënt to the end of his life with even aggravated sufferings." ${ }^{2}$ This is of course unless proper and systematic treatment is given, like Hahnemann.

Hahnemann called chronic diseases. miasms and he recognised three of such

Psora, it is characterised by deficiency on all three levels, mental, emotional and physical. It includes,; Itching skin eruptions and functional (not structural) disturbances. Hahnemann believed that psora resuited from suppressed leprosy. Whether we agree with this or not, most would agree with Kent's statement that everyone is psoric. Psora is the tendency to get sick.

Sycosis, it is characterised by excess on all three levels. We see excess in discharges and growths, Genital and urinary tract problems are seen on the physical plane. Also exuberance and bursts of activity on the mental/emotional level with swings to the opposite extremes in the same person. The complaints usually better at night. Sycosis was said to come from gonorrhoea.

The President of the Indian Institute of Homoeopathic Physicians, Prafull Vijayakar's explanation of vvhy he adheres to only three miasms is basically as follows:

Any living thing in this worid has to degenerate and it does so in a particular way. Also', there are 3 basic functions of any cell:

1. Homeostasis.
2. Growth.
3. Dcfence.

Miasms are nothing but an extension of these functions, but disturbed functions !

1. Homeostasis. Organisation: Deficiency, when disturbed $\rightarrow$ Psora
2. Growth. Generation: Excess, when disturbed —> Sycosis.
3. Defence: Destruction, when disturbed —> Syphilis.

Thus, on the sound basis of physiology also, it can be seen that there are only three basic miasms or in scientific lerms, dysfunctions, possible.

Dr. P.S. Ortega in his book, Notes on the Miasms, puts forward the idea of blends of the three primary miasms. Ortega used the three primary colours to illustrate the view that cach human has his own miasmalic blend, or more simply, each person will be found to have a certain percentage of each of the three primary miasms. These $m$ iasms can be dom inant and active individual ly or dom inant and/or active together. The tubercular and the cancer miasms being examples of the latter.

In this work we are going to analyse the idea of the threc primary miasms psora, sycosis and syphilis coming from the discases leprosy, gonorrhoea and syphilis. The author will present what hc bclieves are facts to show, this is not the case. What we see is that each person has a blend of the three primary miasms and that different circumstances draw them into activitv.
