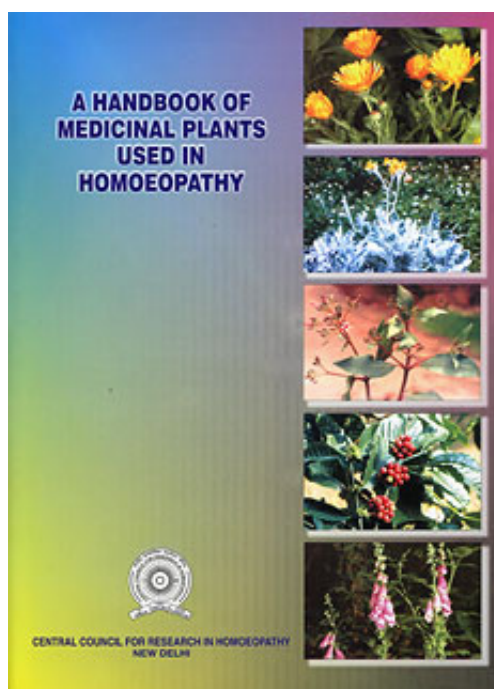

Botanical name Rosmarinus officinalis L.

Family LAMIACEAE (LABIATAE)

Common name *Eng:* Rosemary.

Hindi: Rusmari.

Description Evergreen, shrubs, leaves revolute, linear, green above, pale beneath, flowers pale bluish, white to pale violet.

Distribution Indigenous to South of Europe, Asia Minor and N.Africa; cultivated in the gardens of India.

Part used

Whole plant.

Homoeopathic uses Baldness. Dandruff. Headache. Vertigo. Menses too early. Memory weak. Miscarriage.

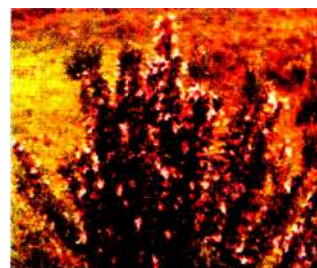

RUBIA TINCTORUM

Botanical name Rubia tinctorum L. RUBIACEAE

Family Common name *Eng :* European Madder. Alizari.
Hindi & Punjabi: Bacho.

Description Prickly or scabrid climbing herb, stems quadrangular, flowers yellowish, fruits globose, ripening red to black.

Distribution Native to South Europe and Asia, found in Kashmir.

Part used Roots.

Homoeopathic uses Splenic anaemia. Chlorosis. Amenorrhoea. Tuberculosis. Disorders of bones.

History & Authority Boericke, Pocket Manual of MM. Clarke, Dictionary of MM. Murphy, Lotus MM.

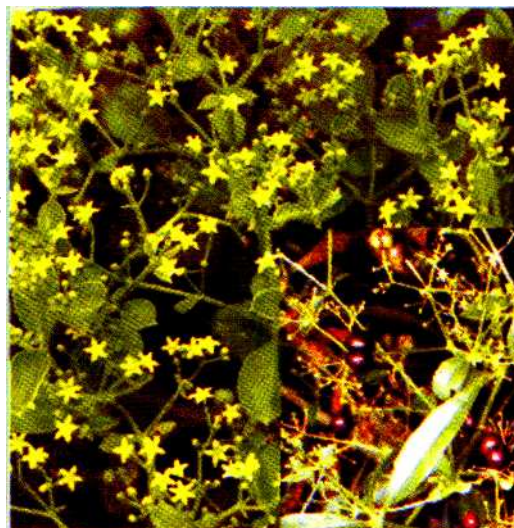
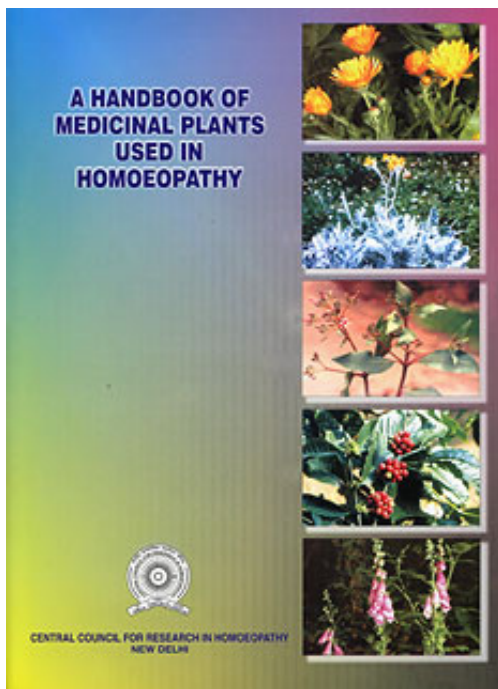
