

Their expectations, hope and prospects are very romantic. The reality is usually very eye-opening and never satisfying.

The conflict between these romantic desires and the disillusioning reality makes TUB. a person who is never pleased and who is looking for something else, something better, something more special for the rest of his life.

#### A. TUB. ON THE MENTAL-EMOTIONAL LEVEL

#### TUB. is romantic

The romanticism of TUB. can be seen in films where a young woman is riding a horse near a lake while holding a hanky for her mouth and constantly coughing. In novels, you can see it in the Three Sisters of Chekov... dreaming their whole life of going to Moscow, but they finally die without ever having been there.

#### TUB. is longing for something better

- Their whole life, TUB. is looking for something better, something else that will please them more, for something that is more special. Internally, they really expect that they will find this.
  - \* They look for a better doctor or homeopath.
  - \* They look for a new, more ideal partner.
  - \* They look for other kinds of sexual pleasure.
  - \* They look for another and better job.
  - \* They want another house or a new interior.
  - \* They travel to find other, better horizons.

#### TUB. is disappointed in reality

- TUB. is disappointed and disillusioned in reality, but at the same time, they desire new, special things.
  - \* The new doctor isn't that good, so they try to find another one.
  - \* The latest partner is not what they expected, so they start looking for a new one.
  - Heterosexuality wasn't satisfying, homosexuality isn't either, so they look for something else.

#### TUB. always wants to change

- TUB. are people who constantly want to change things in their life.
  - \* They change school
  - \* They change their j ob.
  - \* They change doctors
  - \* They take another partner (many divorces)
  - \* They change their house or the interior
  - \* They often go back to the past where everything was better.
  - \* They often change destination while travelling. Sometimes, they are cosmopolitans (K 89: travel, desire to).

#### TUB. is dissatisfied

- TUB.-patients can be disappointed, never really satisfied and very irritable.
  - \* They have tried everything they dreamed of, but nothing was as they expected, so they are never satisfied.
  - \* Consequently, they are difficult people.
  - \* Usually, they are very irritable, everything bothers them, they want to explode but keep themselves under control.
  - \* They can have fits of anger and thereby want to destroy the most beautiful or most expensive things they can put their hands on (K 10: break things, desire to). It is as if they want to show how much they suffer internally.
  - \* They often have a sour expression on the face, displaying their dissatisfaction.
  - \* For their partner, they are most difficult people: never satisfied, you just can't please them.

- \* They have the impression that their life is too short, and want to do many things at the same time.
- \* TUB. can be very idealistic, but then again, they are confronted with reality which disappoints them and makes them unhappy.

### TUB. has a disgust for dogs and cats


- TUB. can be really disgusted by dogs and cats, especially the hair of these animals. They are allergic to these animals sometimes.
- Sometimes, they are afraid of dogs (K 44: fear, dogs).

#### TUB. can have a tendency to contaminate

- In a deeply ill stage, TUB. can have the tendency to make others suffer just as they do. This can go so far that they want to actively contaminate others with the disease they have: TB or Aids.

e.g.: The Aids-patient who consciously wants sexual contact with others with the intention of contaminating them.
