

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THE HOMOEOPATHIC APPROACH TO CANCER

INTRODUCTION

The last few years have witnessed remarkable progress in understanding the biologic and biochemical bases for cancer.

This is not **to** imply that the problem of neoplastic disease is solved, because despite in surgery, chemotherapy, and radiation therapy, cancer accounts for fourth of all deaths in the United States each year.

This paper provides on overview of the definition, etiology, Miasmatic aspects, Homoeopathic treatment followed by a description of the anthroposophical drugs.

Definition

The disease called cancer is best defined by four characteristics which describe how cancer cells act differently from their normal counter parts.

- a) Clonality: In most cases, cancer originates from a single stem cell which proliferates to form a clone of malignant cells.
- **b) Autonomy**: Growth is not properly regulated by the normal biochemical and physical influences in the environment.
- c) **Anaplastic**: There is lack of normal coordinated cell differentiation.
- d) Metastasis: Cancer cells developed the capacity for discontinuous growth and dissemination to other parts of the body.

Philosophy of Tumor Cell Biology

May perspire on slightest exertion—a cold clammy sweat with odour of onions.


The symptoms usually tend to be right sided and then extended to left.

Calcarea phos has hardly any action on cancer or pre-cancerous states.
