


Preface

Many practitioners using my previous book, *Accurate Daily Prescribing for a Successful Practice*, suggested that I focus on a specific topic in greater detail. The present book is a result of that suggestion.

In this work I introduce a controversial proposition. It is this: 70 per cent of people with irritable Bowel Syndrome can be significantly treated with only five different homeopathic medicines. People in this group all have the same miasmatic cause of their illness. It is one of the invisible, morbific and contagious agents, which Hahnemann was not able to fully identify at the time of his writing. Had he lived in the age of microbiology, then his classification of the miasms may have been quite different.

While this proposition may be controversial, it is based on clinical experience, not philosophy. It is also supported by medical research completed independent of my own clinic.
