

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

INTRODUCTION

FLUORINE

Fluorine is a content of hydrofluoric acid and is stored in teeth and bones. A deficiency

of fluorine can lead to tooth decay. Fluoride or compound of fluorine is added to

water supply to prevent tooth decay.

CHLORINE

It is a chief anion of extra cellular fluid. It is a constituent of gastric juice; synthetic

chlorine is an active bleaching agent and germicide, owing to its oxidizing powers. It

is used extensively to disinfect water supplies and treat sewage.

BROMINE

It is the only non-metallic element that is liquid at room temperature. Its action is anti

epileptic, sedative and as sleep producing agent. It produces narcosis, more marked than chlorine. It is a large content of anterior hypophysis. On skin it is irritant or

corrosive and forms painful vesicles or burns that heals slowly

IODINE

Iodine is essential for the normal functioning of human body. It is a non -metallic

element belonging to the halogen group. Iodine is necessary for production of thyroid hormone. Deficiency leads to goitre. It is also used as disinfectant for skin and as a

germicide.

GROUP INDICATIONS

- 1. TENDENCY TO GLANDULAR ENLARGEMENT All halogens have got great affinity for glandular system of the body. The glands specially affected are thyroid, testis, ovaries, breast, tonsils where they produce inflammation, ulceration, abscess formation and tendency towards malignancy.
- 2. All halogens are highly **Irritant** towards **mucous membrane** producing violent **inflammation**, rawness, excoriation congestion, **ulceration**, suppuration and finally **necrosis** with a **rapid pace**.
- 3. TENDENCY TO EMACIATION Halogens emaciate very rapidly as there is nutritional and metabolic imbalance present which occurs because the catabolic process runs faster and nutrition suffers. Hence we find emaciation inspite of ravenous hunger. Hence it is said, "Halogens looses weight even though eating well."
- 4. MARKED affinity FOR HOLLOW ORGANS of the body Halogens have got great affinity for hollow organs like heart, lungs, respiratory system, nose, trachea, bronchi, bronchioles, producing spasm and difficulty in breathing. There is flapping of ala-nasi, bronchospasm and angina. It also produces spasm of glottis, there is laryngismus stridus'.
- 5. TENDENCY FOR 'PSEUDOMEMBRANE FORMATION' especially over tonsils fauces and hence good drug for diphtheria.
- 6. **DISCHARGES** are acrid⁴"³, corrosive, offensive and hemorrhagic.
- 7. **PAINS** Burning pains $^{+3}$, wedge like pains > cold.
- **8. CRAVINGS** for alcoholic drinks.

CONSTITUTION

It is mainly suited to lean, thin cachetic looking persons who are always hungry and hot usually dark skinned except bromine that are blonde. Prematurely old looking people who loses weight, while eating well. Very restless, marasmatic children with tendency to glandular enlargement.

MIND


