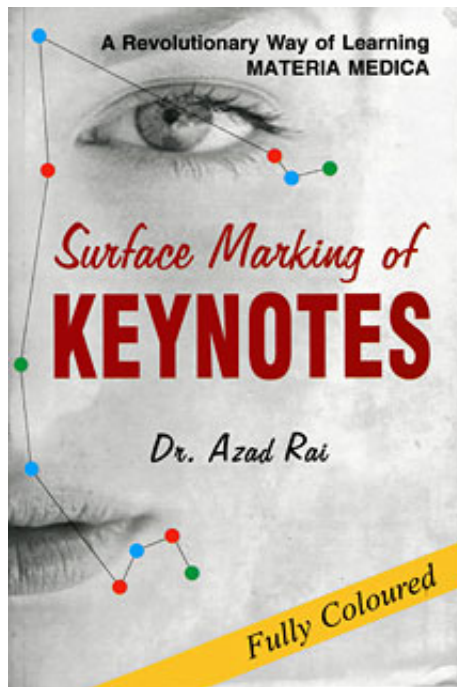

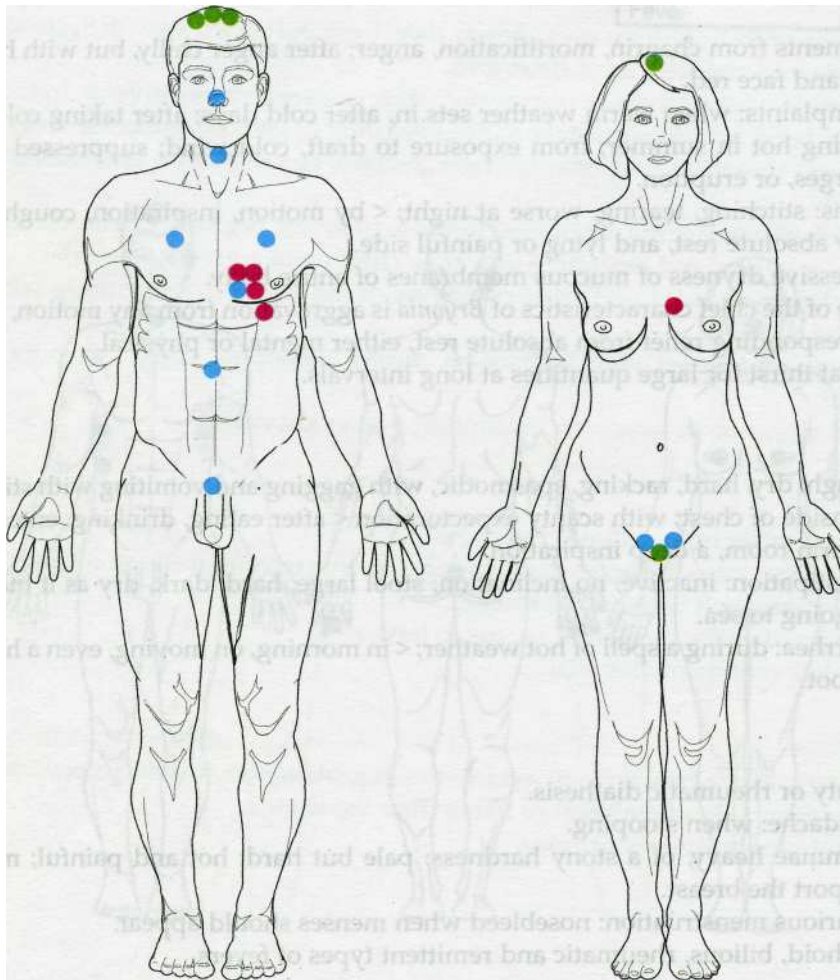

# CACTUS GRANDIFLORUS

Night-blooming Cereus  
Cactaceae

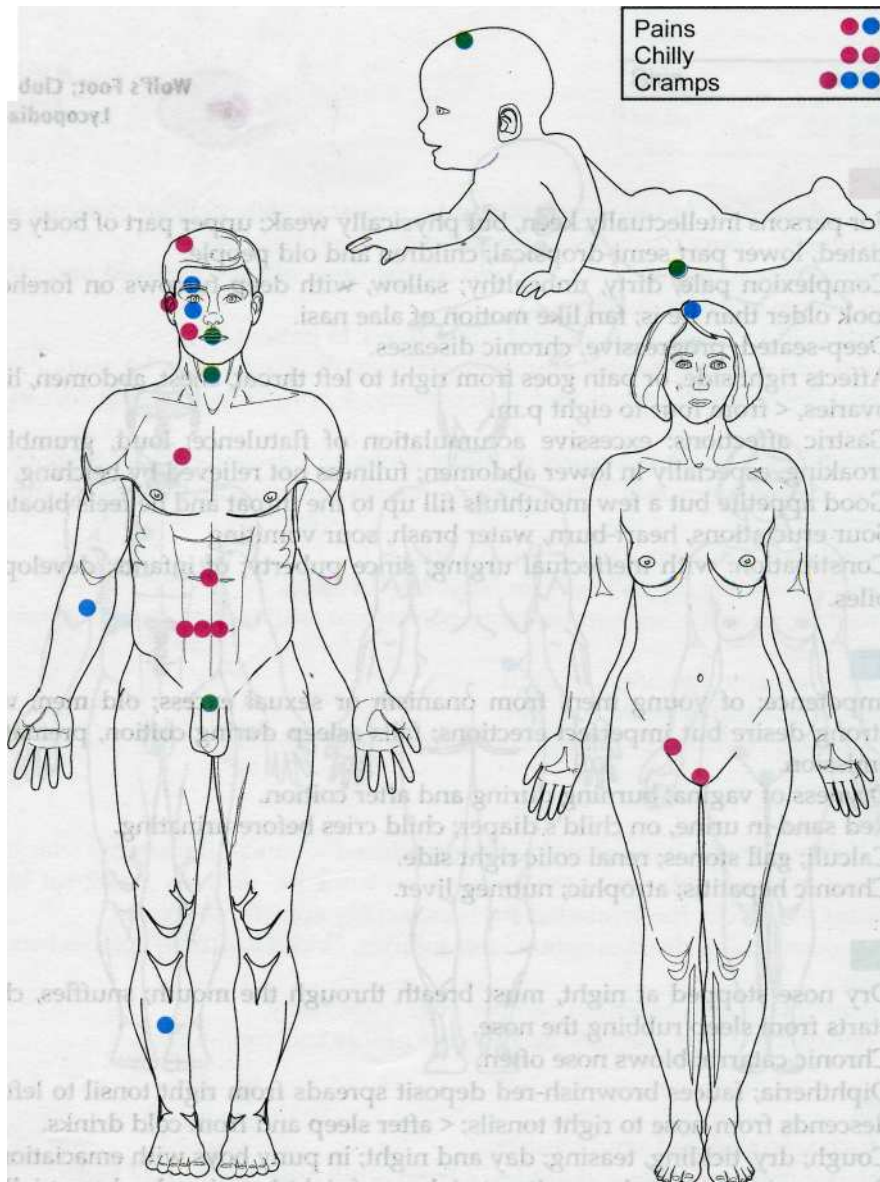
**Whole** body feels as if caged, each wire being twisted tighter and tighter. Oppression of chest, as from a great weight; as if an iron band prevented normal motion. Sensation of a cord tightly tied around lower part of chest, marking attachment of diaphragm. Heart feels as if clasped and unclasped rapidly by an iron hand; as if bound; darting, springing like chain lightning, and ending with a sharp, vise-like grip, only to be again renewed. Palpitation: day and night; worse when walking and lying on left side; at approach of menses.

**Fear** of death; believes the disease incurable. Hemorrhage: from nose, lungs, stomach, rectum, bladder. It affects the circular muscles, there by producing constrictions; of the heart, throat, chest, bladder, rectum, uterus, vagina, neck; often caused or brought on by the slightest contact.

**Sanguineous** apoplexy. Headache, pressing like a heavy weight on vertex; climacteric. Headache and neuralgia; congestive, periodic, right-sided; severe, throbbing, pulsating pain. Menstrual flow ceases when lying down. Fever paroxysm at 11 a.m. and 11 p.m.

# MAGNESIA PHOSPHORICA

Phosphate of Magnesia  
 $\text{MgHP0}_4 \cdot 7\text{H}_2\text{O}$

**Nervous**, tense, and subject to sudden violent paroxysms or neuralgic pains; sharp, cutting, stabbing; shooting, stitching; lightning-like in coming and going; in periodic paroxysm; rapidly changing place; radiating, boring, constricting.

Great dread of: cold air; uncovering; touching affected parts; moving.

Complaints from: cold bathing or washing; standing in cold water; working in cold clay; catheterism; dentition; study.

Affections of right side of body; head, ear, face, chest, ovary, sciatic nerve.

Spasms or cramp of stomach, abdomen and pelvis, with clean tongue. Colic; flatulent, forcing patient to bend double; > by heat, rubbing and hard pressure.

Menses: early; flow dark, stringy; pains < before, > when flow begins; > by heat and bending double; vaginismus; membranous dysmenorrhoea.

**Spasmodic** effects; hiccough; yawning, chorea; twitchings; cramps etc.

Cramps: of extremities; of writers, piano or violin players; during pregnancy.

Headache: of school girls; from mental emotion, exertion or hard study; < 10 to 11 a.m. or 4 to 5 p.m.; > by pressure and external heat. Neuralgia: of face, supra or infra-orbital, ear; right side; intermittent; < by touch, cold air, pressure; > by external heat.

**Ailments** of teething children; spasms during dentition, no tever.

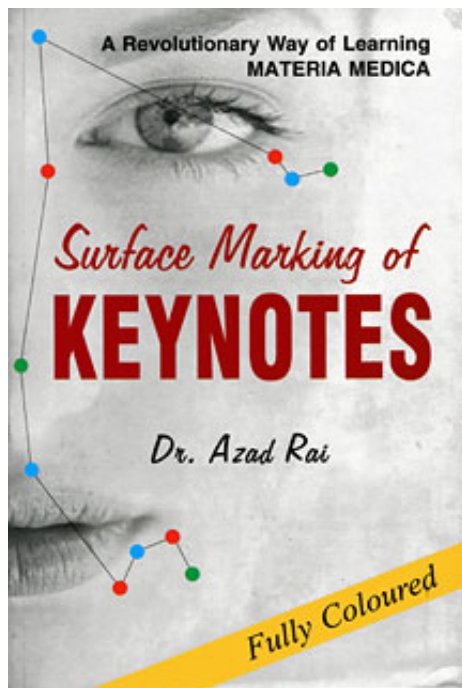
Toothache: at night; rapidly shifting; < eating, drinking, especially cold things; > by heat and hot liquids.

Enuresis; nocturnal; from nervous irritation; after catheterization.

Spasmodic, whooping cough > cool air.

Always talking of her pains.
