



Fever

SELLADONNA

Belladonna

Known commonly as Deadly Nightshade.

General Symptoms

Hot, red, throbbing pains

Inflammation

Bursting, throbbing headaches

Complaints from cold, dry wind or getting head wet

Eyes shinning

Face red, hot glowing

Very sensitive

Onset of a complaint sudden

Pains appear and disappear

Sudden, shooting, throbbing pains

Pupils dilated

Sweat absent during a fever, radiating heat

Symptoms are right-sided

Thirsty

The child may feel Better for lying down or in a warm room

The child may feel Worse for movement, for touch, at 3pm and 3am, draughts and heat

Think Belladonna when a symptom is hot, red, glowing, throbbing and inflamed

Fevers are red and hot with radiating heat but hands and feet are cold

Emotional and Mental Symptoms

Angry and confused Delirious with a fever

Excitable Restless

Screaming with pain Tearful during a fever Sleeplessness Sensitive to light and noise

The person is in turmoil and agitated and delirious with a fever

The eyes are shining and they may become violent

Other uses for Belladonna

Throbbing Headache Colds Flu

Sore Throat Dry Cough Sleeplessness
Earaches Chicken Pox Measles

Mumps Sun Stroke

Background Information

Belladonna is a perennial plant that grows in a shady place throughout Europe. It flowers in July and produces bright red berries in September.

Belladonna eye drops were used in the 16th Century by Italian

women to dilate their pupils and make their eyes sparkle.

The homeopathic preparation is made from the whole plant which is gathered when it is flowering. It is then chopped and pounded to a pulp. The juices are then mixed with alcohol and left to stand for 8 days before filtration and succussion.


